

Code of Conduct for Troop Adults

To ensure that all Scouts and Scouters enjoy a positive experience at Troop 140 events and functions, that adults understand the expectations of the troop, and to maintain the Spirit of Scouting, we ask that all adults accompanying our Scouts read, understand, and follow this Code of Conduct.

The Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmasters, or their designee, are responsible for the supervision of all participants, including maintaining discipline and security, and adherence to the participant Code of Conduct.

While participating in Scout activities:

- I will participate in and be actively involved with the troop during activities. While I understand there might be opportunities for personal activities while accompanying the troop, I will place priority on assisting and supporting the troop. When unsure of how to assist, I will ask the adult in charge.
- I will follow the schedule of the troop including mealtimes and walking/driving to event activities as a troop, unless otherwise directed or agreed upon by the adult in charge.
- I will obey the rules and instructions of the adult leadership and Senior Patrol Leader. This includes not bringing/not using non-permitted items on campouts.
- I will set a good example by keeping myself neatly dressed in the appropriate Scout uniform or specified attire for the given event or activities as determined by the troop or the event organizers.
- I will be respectful to others at all times.
- I will maintain current Youth Protection Training (YPT) and maintain two-deep leadership.
- I will be guided by the Scout Oath and Scout Law, and will obey the regulations, policies, and guidelines of all places we visit.
- I will exemplify Scout Spirit while participating in troop activities.
